

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIDWAY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 4, 2024, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THE MAYOR AND 2 COUNCIL MEMBERS BY QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MIDWAY; ESTABLISHING A POLLING PLACE FOR THE ELECTION; AND MAKING PROVISIONS FOR CONDUCTING THE ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIDWAY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. A General Election is ordered to be held by the City of Midway ("the City") at Midway City Hall on Saturday, May 4, 2024, from the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. At this election the qualified voters of the City will elect a Mayor and 2 Council members with each position having a term of two years.

SECTION 2. The polling place for this election shall be Midway City Hall, 12250 Hwy 21E, Midway, Texas.

SECTION 3. The period for early voting by personal appearance for the general election shall be Monday, April 22 through Friday, April 26, 2024 and Monday, April 29 and Tuesday, April 30, 2024. The Early Voting Clerk for said elections shall be the City Secretary. She shall determine the number of election workers to be hired and arrange for training of all election workers. Early voting by personal appearance for the general election shall be conducted at Midway City Hall with the following hours observed:

Monday, April 22, 2024 through Thursday, April 25, 2024 8 a.m.—5 p.m.

Friday, April 26, 2024 8 a.m.—12 Noon

Monday, April 29, 2024 through Tuesday, April 30, 2024 8 a.m.—5 p.m.

SECTION 4. Early voting by mail ballot shall be conducted in accordance with applicable sections of the Texas Election Code. The address of **12250 Hwy 21 E, Midway, Texas 75852**, shall be the early voting clerk's mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail may be sent for the City.

SECTION 5. The election will be held in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas.

SECTION 6. Notice of election will be published at least once in the newspaper published in Madison County and will be posted on the outdoor bulletin board of City Hall on or before Friday, February 16, 2024.

SECTION 7. The rate of compensation to be paid assistants to the Election Judge/Voting Clerk for services rendered during the election will be no more than \$10.00 per hour.

SECTION 8. If any portion of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. That this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
